## SCHIELE CLINIC TO LAUNCH 2ND RESEARCH PROJECT

Nathan Simon, M.D., Director of the Schiele Clinic, will spearhead a research project studying the Scales of Psychological Capacities (SPC), an instrument designed to measure the structural change in personality organization that results from intensive long-term psychoanalytic based psychotherapy. The broad goal of the project is to study what changes take place in psychoanalytic psychotherapy and psychoanalysis and how those changes are brought about, through interaction factors in the patient, in the therapy and therapist, and in the patient's evolving life situation.

The Institute is pleased to announce a two-year grant totaling \$30,000 from the Gertrude & William A. Bernoudy Foundation.
