OPPORTUNITIES TO APPLY FOR FALL TRAINING PROGRAMS

The **Adult Psychoanalytic Training Program** has a tripartite training model consisting of a personal analysis and didactic education as well as analytic supervision. An analytic education is a life transforming educational experience; students will venture into the realms of the unconscious both didactically and personally.

The **Child Development Program (CDP)** is a two year program offering professional training not ordinarily available to educators in university coursework or other professional training programs. The course curriculum will follow the natural pattern of child development into adolescence. Participants can expect to walk away with a vital understanding of development as it relates to learning.

Our **Clinic Practicum Program** offers Masters and Doctoral candidates the opportunity for an intensive 12-month learning experience in the theory and practice of out-patient Psychodynamic Psychotherapy.
