The Schiele Clinic launches practicum opportunity

Abigail Wilson and Melissa Scolaro, students from the George Warren Brown School of Social Work (GWB), began their practicums at the Institute's Schiele Clinic in July. They will provide individual therapy and evaluations in our clinic and will be supervised by a member of our faculty who is a social worker and approved as a GWB field practicum supervisor. In addition, they will attend clinic meetings, as well as any scientific meetings that we hold.

Library working to improve its technology and implement special projects

The Betty Golde Smith Memorial Library is working on grant proposals to the Missouri State Library and to the National Library of Medicine to provide access to PEP (Psychoanalytic Electronic Publishing) Web Service, and to fund a public-access computer in the Library. Their long-term goal is to put the entire library catalog on the web.

These grants will support the Library's mission to strengthen alliances with other mental health libraries, establishing cooperative initiatives to support psychoanalytic research, teaching, and study in a wide array of mental health professions and to improve access to mental health information, programs and initiatives for the community.

Research project to report preliminary results

Preliminary results of a three-year research project being conducted by the Institute and the Dept. of Psychology, Washington University, will be reported this fall. A \$25,000 grant from the Solon Summerfield Foundation is funding this research project titled, *A Pilot Study of Changes in Self-Regulation through Psychodynamic Psychotherapy*. Participants in the project fill out a questionnaire each week that investigates affect regulation, self-esteem, and interpersonal relationships.
