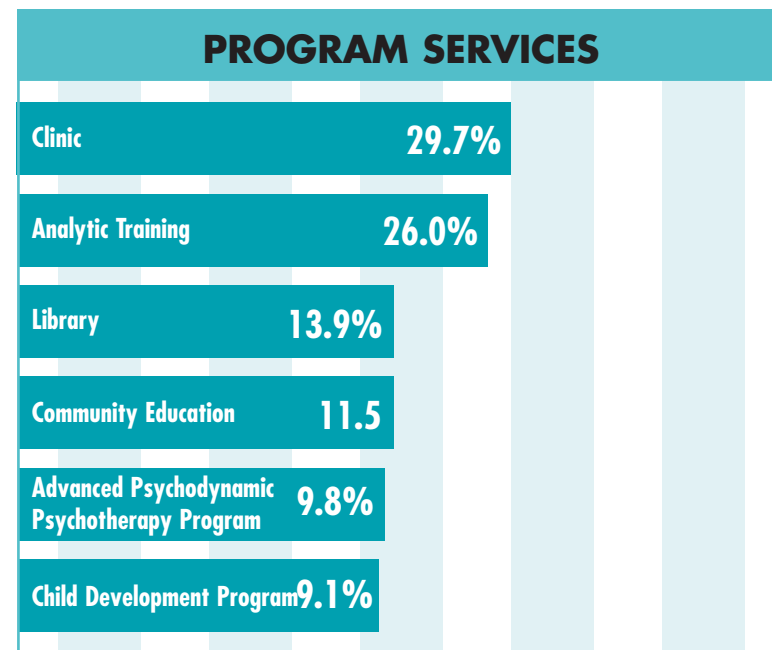
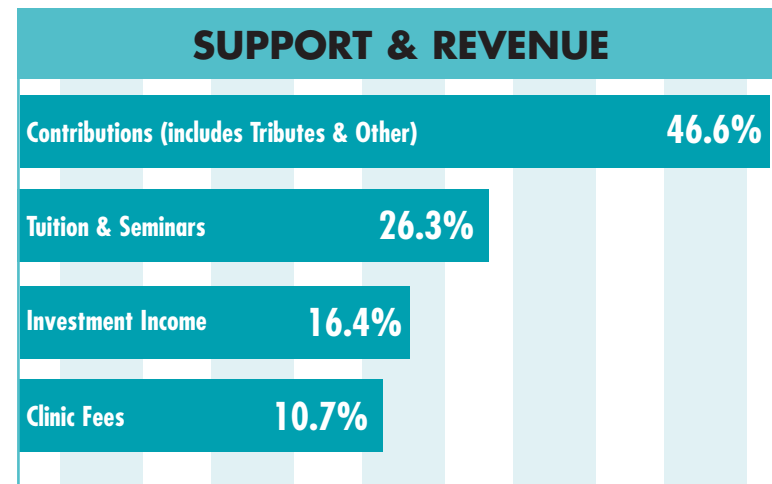

Child Development Program: New Class, Now Forming

Join the next group of school administrators, early childhood educators, social workers, counselors, psychologists, psychotherapists, therapists in special fields, nurses and clergy in an exciting course of study on the psychological issues of childhood through adolescence. The Child Development Program (CDP) provides professional training not ordinarily offered in university course work or other professional training programs.

Participants gain an in-depth understanding of the psychological issues of childhood through adolescence that will aid them in supporting a foundation for sound human development. Graduates are equipped to prevent or detect crises and have the skills for short-term therapeutic intervention as well as the knowledge of when and how to refer to other professionals.

Classes meet from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m. on Thursday evenings during the academic year, for two years. The program includes both course work and small group supervision. Along with assigned readings, students will participate in one hour of supervision per week to integrate theory with its practical applications. PAUL A. DEWALD, M.D. LECTURE PRESENTS “Psychological Roots of Community Violence” with Dr. James Gilligan Thursday, March 6, 2008



“In the course of my psychotherapeutic work with violent criminals, I was surprised to discover that I kept getting the same answer when I asked

one man after another why he has assaulted or even killed someone: ‘Because he disrespected me.’”
Dr. James Gilligan, author and Paul A. Dewald, M.D. Lecture speaker, from his book Preventing Violence (Prospects for Tomorrow).

As the featured speaker for the March 6, 2008 Paul A. Dewald, M.D. Lecture, Dr. James Gilligan represents the St. Louis Psychoanalytic Institute's commitment to the exploration of therapeutic issues vital to the health and well-being of our community. Dr. Gilligan's research and work in violence prevention have made a considerable impact. His program designs for violence prevention in prisons are not only ground-breaking, but they are world-renowned. He has received accolades from the New York Academy of Sciences, the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention of the U.S. Department of Justice, the Polish Ministry of Justice, and the World Health

Organization, among other national and international organizations. One particular violence prevention program that he helped to create won the 2004 “Innovations in Governance” Award from the Ash Foundation, in a nationwide competition held by the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University.

Dr. Gilligan has been clinical supervisor and consultant in forensic psychiatry at the Cambridge Hospital of the Harvard Medical School since 1995. He has also directed mental health programs for the Massachusetts prison system for ten years, and has served as Director of the Institute of Law and Psychiatry and of the Center for the Study of Violence in teaching hospitals of the Harvard Medical School. He has been a visiting professor at New York University, as well as the University of Pennsylvania, bringing his peace work to the next generation. Dr. Gilligan is currently a member of the Academic Advisory Council of the National Campaign against Youth Violence, to which he was appointed by President Clinton. He is the author of *Violence: Our Deadly Epidemic* and its Causes, *Violence in California Prisons: A Proposal for Research into Patterns and Cures*, and *Preventing Violence*.
